## **Workcamps mit zwei Campsprachen:**

Über die explizit französischsprachigen Camps hinaus gibt es in Frankreich, Belgien und der Schweiz Workcamps, in denen Französisch und Englisch gesprochen wird. Die Campsprache ist in den jeweiligen Beschreibungen vermerkt. Insbesondere unser Partner Solidarites Jeunesse (SJ) hat sich zum Ziel gesetzt, auch Franzosen mit geringen Fremdsprachenkenntnissen die Teilnahme an den eigenen Camps zu ermöglichen. Bei den Camps von Solidarites Jeunesse sind (je nach Teilnehmenden) beide Sprachen präsent.

## **Kontakt mit den Einheimischen:**

Besonders Camps bei denen die Arbeit in engem Kontakt mit den ortsansässigen Freiwilligen verrichtet wird, sind zum Sprachtraining geeignet. Wie intensiv der Kontakt mit den Einheimischen ist, ist von Projekt zu Projekt unterschiedlich. Ein Hinweis geben die einzelnen Projektbeschreibungen. Besonders geeignet sind auf jeden Fall Camps in den Bereichen: Arbeit mit Kindern (KIDS), Arbeit mit Behinderten (SOCI, DISA) oder Festivalcamps (FEST). Auch bei einige Renovierungscamps (RENO) unseres Partners Compagnons Batisseurs France (CBF) sind viele Einheimische mit dabei.

# Frankreich

## U01 FESTIVAL D'OLT – 25/05/11-09/06/11 – FEST – 18+ yo – 8 vols

**Partner:** The Rudeboycrew association is a local organisation born in 2004, in Bleybard, a small municipality of Lozère, near the city of Mende (South east of France). This organisation sets up a festival of music and street entertainments every year, from the 13th till the 15th of May in 2010. Usually, a small team of local volunteers, very motivated, comes to help them during the festival. This year, the association wants to mix them with international volunteers to give a supplementary dimension to this project. They will be present before and during the festival for the preparation and the good progress of the event. It will be a time of meeting between the public and volunteers, with a specific aim on ecological issues.

**Work:** You will fully participate to the festival teams. Before the festival, you will help setting up the tents and the stages. Afterwards you have to construct the bar and the decoration of the festival. During the festival you will help manage the artist reception, the accommodation, the bar and snack. After the festival, you will mainly have to tidy up the festival and camping places. An intense festival is waiting for you. It requires flexibility, improvisation and initiatives, so as to benefit from this moment of meetings and exchanges.

**accomodation and food:** Under tents during the festival (as the other volunteers). 1 big tent will be used as a collective place for all the volunteers of the festival. Don't forget a warm sleeping bag and a groundsheet/mattress (more blankets will be provided if necessary)

**location & leisure activity:** Bleybard is a village situated on the beautiful National park of Cévennes, on the edges of the Lot river and near the Mountain Lozère. The village is in the crossing of several riding roads and there is a lot of activities to do in this rural region. Mende, the closest city, is 30 km. The village is a 1037m height and counts a population of 356 inhabitants. The heart of the old village will amaze you by its ancient heritage and its old characteristic houses. All facilities are present in the village: restaurant, bar, post office, bakery, tobacco and press shop, butcher's shop, craft shop, garage and grocer's shop. ## **U02 PLEIN LA BOBINE – 06/06/11-22/06/11 – KIDS – 18+ yo – 10 vols**

**Partner:** Festival Plein la Bobine 2011 = cinema + children + science ! You like one of these themes ? You are interested by 2 or 3 of them ? So, this workcamp is for you! The AFFE (local organisation for a film festival for children) organises every year the festival "Plein la Bobine" for children from 3 to 12 years old which aims to develop programs of visual education in connection with cinema. Every year has a different theme (in 2011 : the Science), celebrates a country (Sweden) and gives free hand to a partner (a Croatian organisation of a cinema festival). All takes place in the casino of the town. places. An intense festival is waiting for you. It requires flexibility, improvisation and initiatives, so as to benefit from this moment of meetings and exchanges.

**accomodation and food:** In an apartment

**location & leisure:** activity CLERMONT FERRAND You will be based on the La Bourboule spa town (at an altitude of 852 metres), in the middle of the Nature Park of Auvergne Volcanoes. La Bourboule stretches on the banks of the Dordogne River crossed by many bridges and has a splendid sequoias wooded area. You will be located near the hiking paths and you will enjoy the activities organized by the municipality for the spa users. You will also have access to the facilities of the town: shops, activities. Caution ! Life in a festival is often hectic and days could be long. This workcamp is different from the others! You have to be available and to know how to react facing emergency situations. You will work everyday during the whole festival.

### **U03 LASKAR THEATRE – 10/06/11-22/06/11 – FEST/CULT – 18+ yo – 5 vols**

**partner:** Clowns, circus, an incredible brass band, capoeira and maybe a beard lady ! If you dream of this mix, come to join the Laskar Théâtre : a clown company between theatre and circus tradition. With a small group of international volunteer (5 persons), you will integrate into the troupe who is preparing the second edition of the Cirque Printanier (= Spring Circus Festival). The aim: to spread the circus and theatre arts in the country. Those who want to be initiated to the circus and clown art are welcome ! **work:** You will integrate the short clowns's troupe and as such you will participate in the setting up of the second edition of the Cirque Printanier (=Spring Circus Festival) : installation of the big top and various equipment, helping to the general logistics link to the shows (signposting, ticket booth, security...). One part of you work will be link to the public : welcome, seating, etc. You will also help in leading workshops (circus, clown make up, ...) often for children. And if you're motivated, you can learn circus and clown arts, and why not dress up (come with you costume if you have one or create one during the workcamp) to participate to one of the performance during this festival !?!

**accomodation and food:** You will sleep, cook and live in the communal home occupied during all the year by the Laskar Théâtre Compagny. Dormitory (for 6 persons) and bathroom shared with the circus troupe. Collective cooking: you will cook and eat with the circus troupe.

**location & leisure activity:** You will be located in Mauzun, a small village about forty km in south western to Clermont-Ferrand. Into the art and history country of Billom Saint-Dier, you will discover the heritage of this country. Mauzun is also the permanent place of the Laskar Théâtre Compagny : you will live the everyday life of the troupe.

**Requirements:** - Your knowledge in activities with children, theatre, circus or other artistic disciplines are very welcome. Novice people but who are interested by theses disciplines and who have creative mind are also welcome. Do you have a funny costume or red nose ? Take it with you ! - The life in a festival is often hectic and days could be long. This workcamp is different from the others! You have to be available and to know how to react facing emergency situations. All the more so you will be only 5 international volunteers integrate into the artistic troupe : you will live to their rhythm and share work, everyday life and friendliness with them! - French speaking camp because you will be in contact with the public

## **U04 MONTPEZAT – 13/06/11-28/06/11 – FEST – 18+ yo – 10 vols**

**Partner:** Montpezat welcomes international volunteers for the second year. This year the old stone path will be covered by land-art and poetry works. Volunteers will help to prepare a week-end exhibition in cooperation with artists.

**Work:** Volunteers will help in doing the land-art exhibition with artists and welcome the public coming to see it. If you want, the group can create its own artistic works. There will be some stone wall work too.

**accomodation and food:** Accomodation will be provided in 3 bungalows, with 4 beds and 1 bathroom in each. Bungalows are in a camping near the center of the village.

**location & leisure activity:** Montpezat is a beautiful rural village of 780 inhabitants located in Ardèche department. People living there are really open minded and dynamic. The wilderness around the village is very beautiful and diverse.

**Requirements:** The local population is happy to welcome again international volunteers. Meeting with local people is really important. Volunteers will come with good shoes for walking (mountains shoes). French speaking camp - intermediate level French required.

## **U05-A AUZAT I – 17/06/11-29/06/11 – ARCH – 18+ yo – 8 vols**

**Partner:** The town of Auzat, situated in a lovely valley in the Pyrenees mountains, has organised archaeological excavations for several years, at the Montréal-de-Sos castle. It was originally built in the XIIIth century, on a rocky promontory. A mule will help you out carrying the needed material. A number of historical pieces has been found on the site: tools, pottery, coins... You will work with local volunteers from all backgrounds as well as with people under professional training.

**Work:** The person in charge of the archaeological project will guide you. The excavation takes place every day; however you will alternate 1 day of work and 1 day off with half of the group, so as to get some rest. On rainy days (if ever there are some!) you will carry out cleaning of the founded objects. This is a work that is sometimes challenging, but quite exciting if you are fond of archaeology.

**accomodation and food:** In tents in the municipal campsite.

**location & leisure activity:** You will stay at the municipal campsite, in the beautiful Vic des Sos valley. A number of painted caves as well as castles are worth a visit in the area.

**Requirements:** To join this workcamp it is compulsory to be vaccinated against tetanus. An attestation will be asked on arrival. Bring very good trekking shoes and a little rucksack! French speaking camp - intermediate level French required.

## **JR11/110 TALLENDE – 19/06/11-02/07/11 – FEST – 18-30 yo – 9 vols**

**Partner:** The festival A l'assaut was born in 2009 from the desire of several young people of the town to mobilize the local population around a musical event. Originally, this project is supported by two separate associations: Faya Rise Festival Committee of Tallende. The meeting between members of these organizations went so well that they decided to merge in the Festival Committee of Tallende, bringing together people of different generations. For the second edition of the festival, the committee and Tallende Sound Hunters Association, co-organizers of the event in 2011, were seeking to host international volunteers as part of a project; to give an international dimension to the festival. Moreover, the municipality of Tallende is located in an area with high environmental dimension. The organizers wish to focus intervention and volunteers on the environmental dimension of the festival.

**Work:** Helping to organize the festival following an environmental frame. Before the festival: making of dry toilets, installation of stands, electricity, barriers, signs ... During the festival : Environmental awareness among the public, information campaigns on the value of using dry toilets. After the festival: bringing down of the installations, site cleanup. **accomodation and food:** You will be accommodated in the sport hall. La Tour d'Auvergne is 500 metres of altitude, bring warm clothes. You will cook in a room of the building; there are a refrigerator and a cook; dishes and kitchenware will be provided. There are shops in the village: minimarket, bakery, butcher, café. Jeunesse et Reconstruction will not be responsible for you if you arrive before the beginning of the project. No lodging in Tallende. **location & leisure activity:** Tallende counts 1 187 inhabitants. This picturesque village is located in the Natural Regional Park of the Volcanoes of Auvergne, between the Massif du Sancy and the Puys' assembly lines. Close to Clermont-Ferrand (20 km away). After the end of the festival, the volunteers of the organisation will make you discover this beautiful territory.

### **Requirements:**

- 1/ At the end of the work camp, no transportation will be organized by our association. You will then have to arrange your own means of transport to return to the train station.
- 2 / Our association does not provide a car during the work camp.
- 3 / Foreigners belonging to the European Union must bring with them a personal EHIC (European Health Insurance Card, for the refunding of medical expenses in your country).
- 4 / If you have a driving licence, please bring it along in case of necessity. Do not forget to bring: a sleeping bag, warm clothes (a sweater and rain-coat), a bathing suit. For male volunteers: short pants are generally prohibited in the public swimming pools in France, please bring a bathing suit. For work: worn out clothes and strong shoes (like boots – obligatory for your own safety). Your games, songbooks, cassettes, musical instruments and recipes, will be also welcome! To make

exchanges and encounters easier, please also bring photographs of your home, some postcards, and small gifts.

## **U06 LA BOUCHURE – 24/06/11-08/07/11 – CULT – 18+ yo – 10 vols**

**Partner:** Festival of La Bouchure : contemporary and eclectic music in rural France ! For the 6th consecutive year, the organisation Les Bouchures is happy to host international volunteers to help in the implementation of a amplified music festival. The “bouchure” designated locally the field hedge because one of the characteristic of this music festival is to be located in rural area and to be touring (moving from a village to another). On the program: 4 days of music festival in 4 villages & 70 local volunteers hosting around 10 music groups and 8000 spectators! Be ready to live on the steady rhythm of this festival, to adapt yourself to the unexpected of these 4 happy days. In return, the workcamp will be rich in meeting and cultural discoveries : the members of the local association will introduce you to the region’s discovery and to their passion for the ‘contemporary musics’. Because the festival is touring, this job again repeat each day : caution, the work’s rhythm is heavy during the 4 festival days ! Free hand will be let to the group for the creation of signages inside the concert sites : good ideas and creative minds are welcomed !

**accomodation and food:** In the village hall converted in dormitory room; kitchen right on site and showers five minutes walking from there(sport stadium’s locker room).

**location & leisure activity:** You will live in the small town of Commentry in the heart of the Bourbonnais region in the Allier department. Former mining city, today it is a pleasant place for its 7,000 inhabitants and its tourists. You will find shops, parks and would go around its rich heritage linked to its industrial past... you will have walks in the surrounding area (lakes, typical villages...)

**Requirements:**The life in this festival is often hectic and days could be long. This workcamp is different from the others! **Partner:** Project Do you want to spend two weeks working with kids in the village of Paris in Estonia? Then this camp is for you! The camp is organized for kids and teenagers by the Association of Teachers of French in Estonia. The main aim of the camp is to provide intensive experience of learning and practicing French for kids and teenagers outside school curriculum using facilities of children camp Pariisi. The camp program includes games and activities, performances in the open air, hikes, excursions and visits, talks and discussions in the working groups.
